- Has a 30+ year history of producing great spiritual fruit within families
- Is spreading across the US and beyond as the answer to the current catechetical crisis
- Has an adult education and formation component at its core
- Is faithful to the Magisterium and on the USCCB Conformity List
- Is driven by Sacred Scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church
- Cooperates with the 3-year liturgical cycle



Family Formation will equip parents in your parish to pass on the Catholic Faith to their children, enabling all to grow in their faith together as a family. Family Formation provides a unique, challenging, and creative curriculum that is family-based, includes adult catechesis and training for parents, is solidly grounded in the Truth and teachings of the Catholic Church, and is designed to encourage all family members to embrace living and learning the Faith as a life-long adventure.
