EXTRA, EXTRA FOR PARENTS

The best way to give our children this solid faith foundation is to lead by example and read the Bible daily. Find a children's Bible with pictures and set aside 10 minutes each day to read to your child. Seek the Lord your God each day by reading His inspired Word — the Bible!





Sacred Scripture in the Life of the Church
